


Two moms lost their sons to PTSD and have raised \$215,000 for Service Dogs






Archbishop Blesses & Supports our Program. Funds were raised for the Archbishop and he named a Service Dog in "Hope Ahepa"

Sons of Pericles fulfil their obligation to sponsors a Service Dog & name him "Pericles "




Archbishop Elpidophoros of America Blesses & Supports our Program


tion and zeal.

Every so often a humanitarian cause comes along that captures our imagination and causes us to stand up and answer the call of duty. So many of our American heroes come home from war physically, but mentally remain on the battlefield. They are imprisoned by their own thoughts, which causes 22 veterans every single day battling PTSD and choose to commit suicide, rather than live with the effects of their invisible battle scar.

Service dogs, or think of them as a medical instrument on 4 legs at \$6,000 each, have proven to help mitigate the veterans suffering and helping them get their lives together. The service dogs are rescue dogs, just imagine saving a life to save a life.



You see taking care of our veterans is a sacred obligation that we must all honor. It is with deep gratitude to the whole AHEPA Family for undertaking such a noble effort to help save two lives: the veteran's and the service dog that was rescued from a dog shelter.


To date \$960,000 (94 service dogs) has been raised plus many more Service Dogs have been pledged. We are proud to say that our expenses to date are **ZERO**.
